I. Reminder of Invitation and Aims of Kingdom Life

We invite you to join EOZ in Starting off 2026 with 10 Days of “Kingdom Life” *focused on JESUS.*

No King but Jesus! No Throne but His!

Let's come together, immersed in the Word with the help of Holy Spirit, offering ourselves as a holy offering, asking God to anoint and use us for advancing his Kingdom purposes.

This month: **JESUS!** Learn / sharpen spiritual skills:

- *discern and know* who He is,
- *speak His story* for others to know Him,
- *war from His identity* to prevail in spiritual warfare.

YOU ARE INVITED to join us for the special focus on **JESUS** in the Kingdom Life spiritual growth track for the month of Tevet.

1. We will begin on Monday, January 5 for 10 days: M-F week 1 and M-F week 2 with individual Bible, prayer, and worship assignments.

2. We are planning four 30-minute team zoom sessions on Tuesdays and Thursdays (January 6,8,13,15) from 6:30 - 7:00 pm. If you cannot make these sessions, you are still invited to enroll in Kingdom Life to join us for the growth work, to stay in step, and to press in for advancing in the Kingdom this month, in spiritual agreement!

Who Jesus Is!

This Troop is focusing on territorial and generational intercession and spiritual warfare, which has the power to open the atmosphere wider for a prolific Harvest.

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"Kingdom LIFE" Spiritual Growth Track Concepts:

We together are His people; He alone is our God!

How can I flourish in Kingdom Life - in community, and on a multi-gifted team?

How can we help others flourish in Kingdom Life?

The Lord calls us to **WHOLENESS individually, and to FULLNESS together.**

We invite you to an ongoing journey together with God's Kingdom people to know our King Jesus in an experiential way, deeper and greater. Be empowered by Holy Spirit to testify of the amazing goodness of Kingdom life in Jesus! Be open to the Holy Spirit maturing us, and forming us into the image of Jesus, more and more, as we listen and obey Him through spiritual disciplines.

Multi-gifted Teams Sent on Assignment

Our trajectory as His Kingdom people in this EOZ Troop, engaging in online/ home, city, and regional gatherings: we show up in submission for Him to use us together as love warriors for the unstoppable forward movement of the ever-expanding Kingdom of God. Think multi-gifted teams sent on assignment in spiritual agreement, maintaining an atmosphere thick with love.

We want to give God what He wants: a family that knows Him and makes Him known (among additional good things!)

We live, grow, learn and practice *Kingdom Life* together so we can be **spiritually fruitful together**. Two weeks a month we gather online in teams toward growing in our relationship with God in word and worship, mission and ministry. We cultivate a lifestyle of deepening relationship with Him, hearing His Voice - and using ours to pray, love, serve, testify, and praise Him.

Find your place in the (Kingdom life-together) Troop God has for you at this time in your life. We welcome you to come explore and walk with us for a while and be refreshed and recharged - or come and be part of us as Holy Spirit leads, for exploits together with fruit that lasts eternally.

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II. Welcome to Kingdom Life for Tevet 5786!

Day 1: In your KL Journal, 1) describe Jesus, 2) and write His story. Make each one paragraph or as long as you like. (Hint: highly recommend you do not skip establishing this baseline, to which you will add as Holy Spirit enriches.)

Next, please click to listen and worship the Lord with this modern hymn, (as many times as you like throughout these ten days.) Add your faith! *See the King of glory. See His love and*

mercy. See the generation rising with selfless faith.

See the near revival stirring as we pray and seek. Now see in the first

bridge Wholeness

Individually: "Heal my heart and make it clean... everything I am for your Kingdom's cause..." And see in the second bridge Fullness Together: "Since



we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses let us run with perseverance the race marked out, **let us make a way for those who are to come...** with one voice they will sing" *Hosanna!*

==> Interact with Holy Spirit, and record in your KL journal anything Holy Spirit helps you perceive. Be ready to share with the group any of these things which may edify the group (other things are for you individually.)

==> Please pray for the others in *Kingdom Life*, and pray for Holy Spirit to lead and empower us to serve His Kingdom purposes in our individual and shared assignments and fields. May we see visible change from this shared exploit in these two weeks and beyond.

III. Discern and Know Who Jesus Is. Speak His story for others to know Him.

(team session tonight) **Day 2: Contemplate** how well John knew Jesus - and then received a further, powerful revelation decades later.

Read **Revelation 1:5-7,12-18; 2:1,8,12,18; 3:1,7,14; 22:12-13,16-18**
and Read **Revelation chapter 5; 7:9-17; 17:14; 19:6-16; 21:22-22:5.**

In your KL Journal add some of these descriptions of Jesus and details about His story from the book of Revelation. What does Holy Spirit highlight to you, clarifying, broadening, or deepening your understanding of who Jesus is?

Day 3: Contemplate how John began telling the message-story of Jesus, "The Word". **Jesus revealed Himself and the Father, and gave us Holy Spirit so**

people can discern and know Him. God wants a family who knows Him and makes Him known.



Read John 1.

Now read chapters 14, 15 in John.

In your KL Journal add some of these descriptions of Jesus and details about His story. What does Holy Spirit highlight to you, clarifying, broadening, or deepening your understanding of who Jesus is?

(team session tonight) **Day 4:** Contemplate how Jesus said Holy Spirit would remind us about what Jesus said and did. Press in to Holy Spirit as you contemplate John's recording of 7 "I AM" saying of Jesus.

Read the context of these verses in John to see how Jesus revealed who He is, and how we can live through Him, the uniquely Divine Son of God sent to bring us into Father's Household forever.



I AM the Bread of Life John 6:35

I AM the Light of the World John 8:12

I AM the Gate (Door) for the Sheep John 10:9

I AM the Good Shepherd John 10:11

I AM the Resurrection and the Life John 11:25–26

I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life John 14:6

I AM the True Vine John 15:1

In your KL Journal add some of these descriptions of Jesus and details about His story. What does Holy Spirit highlight to you, clarifying, broadening, or deepening your understanding of who Jesus is?

Also, you may be greatly edified in turning these I AM sayings of Jesus into a prayerful, declaration of faith. Tip: you may want to use phrases such as “when we follow You...” and “through You, we...” and “You sustain us in your everlasting life and love by...”.

Emphasize speaking this with loving adoration to the Bridegroom, as part of the Bride, not only individually. Of course this will be intimately personal from you to Jesus - AND also speaking it as part of His adoring warrior Bride will prepare our resolve for when we take our stand *together* as His Troop, “No King but Jesus, no throne but His!”

Day 5: Contemplate how Jesus said Holy Spirit would remind us about what Jesus said (John 14:26), and Paul said we have received the Holy Spirit so we may understand what God has freely given us (1 Cor 2:12). Press in to Holy Spirit as you contemplate John’s recording of these particular **7 miracles/ signs of Jesus**.

Water Turned into Wine John 2:1–11

Healing the Royal Official’s Son John 4:46–54

Healing the Man at the Pool of Bethesda John 5:1–15

Feeding the Five Thousand John 6:1–14

Walking on the Water John 6:16–21

Healing the Man Born Blind John 9:1–41

Raising Lazarus from the Dead John 11:1–44

John 20:30-31 Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

John 21:35 Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written.

In your KL Journal add some of these descriptions of Jesus and details about His story. What does Holy Spirit highlight to you, clarifying, broadening, or deepening your understanding of who Jesus is?

Day 6: Contemplate why Jesus left it all to come lay down his life.

John 17, 18, 19. Eph 2:1-10; Col 1:15-20; 2:1-15. Rom 5:1-11.

In your KL Journal add some of these descriptions of Jesus and details about His story. What does Holy Spirit highlight to you, clarifying, broadening, or deepening your understanding of who Jesus is.

Bonus: Draw Him a picture, dance with Him, write Him a poem, or do an act of kindness in His Name such that He would enjoy seeing the freedom you live in, through Him.

(team session tonight) **Day 7:** Contemplate how people told his story in Scripture.

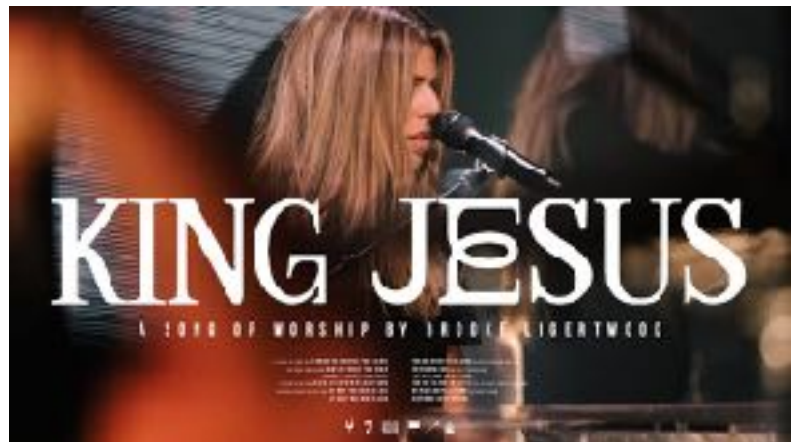
On our team session, prepare to tell His story briefly in your own words.

There is no limit to how many minutes long you want to be prepared to testify of Jesus whenever you have the opportunity. In consideration of saving time for others to share in our 30 minute session, please limit it to 2-3 minutes.

Savior and KING! **Read 1 Cor 15; Luke 24:46–47; Phil 2:6-11; Rom 3:21-26; Acts 2:22–36; 10:34–37; John 1:1-18; 18:36-37**

In your KL Journal add some of these descriptions of Jesus and details about His story. What does Holy Spirit highlight to you, clarifying, broadening, or deepening your understanding of who Jesus is?

Worship King Jesus!



IV. War from His Identity to Prevail in Spiritual Warfare - from our covenant as His people *“in Christ”*.

Day 8: Let's remember our recent Bible teaching examining how Jesus prevailed in spiritual warfare in Jerusalem at the Hanukkah celebration, by revealing His identity in words and deeds. Click for a shortened, 20 min compilation from 3 sessions, exploring this as a spiritual warfare strategy.



(team session tonight) Day 9: Next, let's prevail together in spiritual warfare, that the gates and throne in our territory belong to King Jesus! Yes, this is an ongoing battle until He returns to vanquish our defeated enemy and bring heaven to earth fully, making all things new (Rev 21:5 mission). Meanwhile, we live in two realms - in heavenly and earthly realms. While we steward the earth/ territory/ fields/ family..., we are ambassadors of Jesus' Kingdom, with the message, "Be reconciled to God!" (2 Cor 5:17-21). As Jesus is enthroned in more hearts, darkness retreats! Part of our work is to open the territory for the light and glory of God to be revealed and received, as was done for us when we believed.



Prepare for our team session tonight by reviewing your KL Journal. Also, please listen to this song and worship the Lord. (Anne) hears in it the sound of people hearing and believing Jesus' story. Yes the words - but also the breakthrough sound from heaven. Pray and prophesy as the Lord leads. Intercede for hearing, believing, receiving, and new life!

Tonight, together, let's push back darkness, as Holy Spirit leads, from the hearts and minds of believers in our territory/ realm who are tempted to abandon the Lord - and also unbelievers who have yet to be brought from the kingdom of darkness into the glorious freedom of the children of God!

Remember the "Hosannah" song lyrics that we began with on day one. Let's stop that which would dare stop the move of God in the generation rising with selfless faith!

Ask Holy Spirit to reveal what plans, traps, mind-war assaults the enemy is trying to use to capture those who belong to Jesus. We say no way! Let's practice again together with the approach that Jesus used to prevail - let's war from HIS IDENTITY/ HIS STORY/ HIS MISSION, lighting up dark places, immobilizing evil's plans and advance into this harvest, which belongs to the Lord of the harvest!

Day 10: Contemplate how Jesus is the **Mediator of a New Covenant between God and His People**. Thank Him that you are included in His People! We belong to Him, and some way to each other. See the beautiful Body of Christ as *"my people!"* Contemplate the blessing of being connected and moving together with others who share this Covenant Jesus made.

Read Ephesians chapter 2; 1 Tim 2:5-6; Heb chapter 8; 9:11-15; 12:18-29

In your KL Journal add some of these descriptions of Jesus and details about His story. What does Holy Spirit highlight to you, clarifying, broadening, or deepening your understanding of who Jesus is?

Worship this weekend! Here is a 7 minute worship/ love declaration in song. Enter and offer your worship to the One who is our covering. (click to play on youtube.) As you sing it to Him intimately, over and over, see if something forms stronger inside.



"In You I'm home again..." And, picture the Bride singing it to Him, a collective "I" - it describes the sabbath rest of our salvation. As you worship in this way, see if the **STRENGTH** to war from the peace won by our Prince of Peace arises greater!
